Corrie Primary and Nursery School Social Media Policy

With the increase use of social media it is important to ensure wherever possible, that all

staff and pupils of Corrie Primary and Nursery School are protected against becoming the

targets of cyber abuse/bulling.

Cyber abuse/bulling may consist of threats, harassment, embarrassment, humiliation,

defamation or impersonation. It may take the form of general insults, or prejudice based

abuse (e.g. homophobic, sexist, racist or other forms of discrimination). It may involve email,

chat rooms, websites, social media networks etc.

This policy is to make pupils/parents and carers aware of their responsibilities regarding their

use of social media, email, chat rooms, websites etc.

1. Pupils/Parents/Carers are not expected to post pictures of pupils other than their own

children on social media sites.

2. Pupils/Parents/Carers should make complaints through official school channels

rather than posting them on social media sites.

3. Pupils/Parents/Carers should not post malicious or fictitious comments on social

media sites about any member of the school community.

4. Pupils/Parents/Carers should not make abusive or threatening comments,

harassment, and embarrassment, on social media sites about any member of the

school community.

Parents/Carers should note that if a Pupil/Parent/Carer is found to have posted abusive,

threatening, libellous and/or defamatory comments on social media sites, they will be

reported to the website host. The school expects the person who posted the comment to

remove the comments immediately. In serious cases, the school will consider its legal

options.
