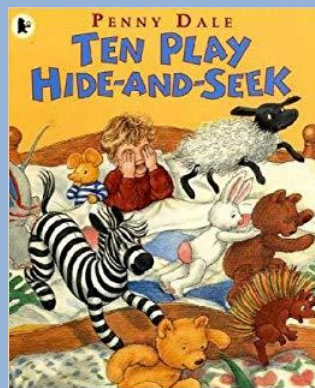

Ten Play Hide and Seek

Maths Focus - Adding and subtraction, memory



Read/Listen to the story together.

1. Can your child predict who is the last animal to be found? Can your child remember where each character hid?
2. Play hide and seek at home or in the park.
3. Hide your child's teddy bears or toys around the home, and get them to find them. Can they use the preposition words to tell you where they found them. Encourage the use of words such as, 'over, under, inside, outside, behind, above.....'
4. Play a memory game, place some number cards or different objects on the table. Get your child to close their eyes. Take something away. Can they tell you what is missing? Add more items, or take 2 away to make it harder.
5. Count forwards and backwards to 10. Write numbers to 10 on some paper and see if your child can put them in the right order.
